DIRECTIONS TO FLAT ROCK ESTATES

FROM INDIANAPOLIS - take I-65 south to exit 19 Henryville. Turn right on to State Road 160 (west). Go 4.5 miles turn left into Flat Rock Estates. Go to the top of the hill the Pavilion is on the left and camp ground is on the right.

FROM LOUISVILLE - take I-65 north to exit 19 Henryville. Turn left on to State Road 160 (west). Go 4.5 miles turn left into Flat Rock Estates. Go to the top of the hill the Pavilion is on the left and camp ground is on the right.

WHAT DOES IT COST TO ATTEND?

Even though the economy has tanked this year, we didn't raise any prices. It's still \$10 per person, per night to camp and \$5 per person for the meal and beer (no camping); children under 16 are free. Someone will be present to collect the fees and answer any questions.

CAMPING INFORMATION

This year all camping will be on the hillside across the street from the Pavilion and no camping east of Sydney Lake. The attached map and photos describe the camping area layout. Bring your own tent and sleeping bag and your own chair.

There will be water available and limited electric. RV's can park on the road but can't block the road.

A barn located away from the camping area is available for overnight shelter but is now used for livestock so you will be sleeping with the Barnsmell family.

Portable Toilets will be provided in the campground and pavilion area. Fire pits and firewood are provided, no fires on the ground.

Everyone is encouraged to stay overnight if you drink adult beverages, the roads home are difficult in the dark and not worth taking the risk. Be a responsible driver.

The owner asks that we do not park on the grass, please park all vehicles on the asphalt roads and avoid blocking other vehicles from exiting the area.
